Obituary

Mr. Robert B. Peiffer, 89, a resident of Quincy Village, Quincy, PA and formerly of Mont Alto, PA, passed away Thursday, April 21, 2011 in Waynesboro Hospital, Waynesboro, PA.

Born July 22, 1921 in Waynesboro, he was the son of the late Charles Raymond and Inez (Cauffman) Peiffer. He was a lifelong resident of the Waynesboro and Mont Alto areas.

Mr. Peiffer was a graduate of Waynesboro High School with the Class of 1939.

He served in the United States Army during World War II in the Pacific Theater.

He and his wife of 68 years, Mrs. Susan (McLaughlin) Peiffer, were married February 1, 1943 in Winchester, VA. They moved to Mont Alto in 1951 and to Quincy Village in November 1995.

Prior to World War II, Mr. Peiffer was employed at Landis Machine Company, Waynesboro. Prior to his retirement on July 31, 1983, he was employed by Allegheny Power, formerly West Penn Power Company, for 37 i; ½ years.

He was a member of the former Otterbein United Methodist Church, Mont Alto, where he served as a Past Trustee. He also was a life member of Mont Alto Volunteer Fire Company and A.T. H. & L Fire Company, Waynesboro and was a member of South Chapter AARP #2977 and National AARP.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Peiffer is survived by his daughter, Sara P. Shank and her husband, Adrian J. of Odenton, MD; his granddaughter, Elizabeth Shank of Philadelphia; one sister, Phyllis Huffman of Greencastle, PA; and a number of nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Louise Heckman and June Madden; and a brother, Donald Peiffer.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 P.M., Monday, May 2, 2011 in the Bryson Room, Quincy Village, 6596 Orphanage Road, Waynesboro, with the Rev. Guy R. Baer officiating. Burial will be private in Green Hill Cemetery, Waynesboro.

The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service in the Bryson Room.
