He also worked as a water plant operator for the Mossy Public Service District for 11 years. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ashtoreth Stevens Wriston; three brothers, Arlie Ray Wriston of Oak Hill, Troy William Wriston of Minerva, Ohio, and Emmett Morris Wriston of Mossy; four sisters, Virtue Hassig of Charles-ton, Zola T.
